

SERVICE DIRECTORY

The services and emergency numbers for towns and cities are listed. There are partial listings for a few of the larger cities near, but not on, the **TransAmerica Trail**. Services between towns are also listed. Libraries are noted for internet usage; access will vary depending on the library. Small town post offices often have limited hours of operation.

Three-digit codes are listed and must be used as a prefix (similar to country codes in Europe) when dialing a service listed beneath it. Area codes will change throughout the Directory.

Within a town or city, call the number listed in case of emergency. Outside towns or in small communities with no police, call the listed sheriff's number. Law enforcement officers have proved repeatedly to be cyclists' best allies on our routes.

Campgrounds and hostels vary from basic services to modern facilities; prices vary accordingly. The motels, hotels, and bed and breakfasts that are listed are only representative of what is available, especially in larger towns. They are often located off route, call for directions.

Cyclists Only Camping or Lodging is an accommodation type offered in private homes, churches and community-run properties on or near the route. These offerings range from camping in a yard or on a lawn to a bed indoors. Each place varies so amenities will differ. Sometimes a fee is charged, ask in advance.
